Au Pair Program, 2019-2023

The U.S. Department of State BridgeUSA Au Pair program enables international participants to stay with American host families while providing childcare and participating in cultural exchange. The program allows au pairs to immerse themselves in American life while caring for host children, helping with schoolwork, and participating in family activities. While doing so, au pairs receive a stipend, room and board, and attend educational courses. American families in turn benefit from the program by exposing their children to other cultures and languages. In 2023, a total of 21,419 au pairs took part in the program across the U.S.⁴ Participants come to the U.S. on non-immigrant J-1 visas.






The Au Pair Program Advances American Interests

- Spread the word about the program and their experience in the U.S. with their networks via conversations, presentations, and social media




U.S. host families report that the program...

- Promotes cultural engagement between their children and their au pair




The Au Pair Program Increases Mutual Understanding
